

FITTING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1) Remove the heel guard shown in Picture 2.
- 2) Remove the plastic OEM chain guard by removing the three bolts in the location shown in the **fitting picture.**
- 3) Place the spacer (**Item 2**) into place over the silver boss circled in **GREEN** in the fitting picture and place the R&G chain guard (**Item 1**) into place, lining up the 3 mount points.
- 4) Thread the OEM bolts into their original positions.
- 5) Tighten all three to the correct torque settings using the OEM torque settings for the bolts used and replace the OEM plastic heel guard.

Please note: Remember to check the torque setting when performing routine maintenance (cleaning/servicing chain).



NOTICE DE MONTAGE

- 6) Retirez le protège-talon illustré sur la photo 2.
- 7) Retirez le carter de chaîne en plastique d'origine en dévissant les trois boulons à l'emplacement indiqué sur la photo de montage.
- 8) Placez l'entretoise (article 2) sur le bossage argenté entouré en VERT sur la photo de montage et placez le carter de chaîne R&G (article 1) en alignant les 3 points de fixation.
- 9) Vissez les boulons d'origine dans leurs positions d'origine.
- 10) Serrez les trois boulons au couple de serrage correct en utilisant les valeurs de couple d'origine des boulons utilisés et remettez le protège-talon en plastique d'origine.

Note : N'oubliez pas de vérifier le réglage du couple lors de l'entretien de routine (nettoyage/entretien de la chaîne).
