



FITTING INSTRUCTIONS FOR EH0003BK EXHAUST HANGERS
APRILIA RSV1000R 2004-WITH TWIN EXHAUSTS



Please note that the way the kit is packed does not necessarily represent the way of mounting to the bike

Please note that in cases where kits are packed with rubber washers holding the components onto the bolt – *the rubber washers should be thrown away!*

In this kit there should be.

1 x EH0003 LHS

1 x EH0003 RHS

6 x M8 x 20mm Black button head bolts

2 x M8 Nyloc nuts

- Remove the original rear foot peg/exhaust hanger bracket.
- Place two of the M8 button head bolts from kit through the two top holes in the R&G hanger.
- Offer up to bike as shown above and engage threads (do not tighten yet).
- Place one of the M8 button head bolt from kit through the exhaust mounting hole (lower hole in bracket) and through the exhaust mounting bracket, place M8 nyloc nut on exposed end of bolt.
- Tighten all bolts evenly.
- Repeat the above operations for the opposite exhaust hanger bracket.
- Please ensure when the motorcycle is being used that no parts are in such a position that they may collide/damage other bike parts (this is particularly important if using after-market cans or exhaust systems).

Please note that it is your responsibility to ensure that no part of the exhaust hanger or exhaust assembly fouls or comes into contact with other parts of the



machine. Do not ride the motorcycle until this aspect has been verified and you have compressed the rear suspension (if appropriate to the design of the motorcycle) to test this thoroughly.

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**INSTRUCTIONS DE MONTAGE EH0003BK / SUPPORT POT
D'ÉCHAPPEMENT (PAIRE)
APRILIA RSV1000R 2004-AVEC 2 ÉCHAPPEMENTS**



La façon dont le kit est emballé ne correspond pas forcément à la façon de monter les pièces sur la moto.

Notez que si les kits sont emballés avec des rondelles en caoutchouc servant à tenir les composants, ces rondelles doivent être jetées.

Le kit doit contenir :

- 1 x EH0003 gauche
- 1 x EH0003 droit
- 6 x M8 x 20mm boulons noirs
- 2 x M8 Ecrous Nyloc

- Enlever le repose pied arrière / Support d'échappement.
- Placer 2 des boulons M8 du kit à travers les 2 trous supérieurs dans le support R&G.
- Monter le sur la moto comme indiqué ci dessus et engager les filetages (ne pas bloquer pour le moment).
- Placer un des boulons M8 du kit à travers le trou du support d'échappement (le trou du bas dans le support) puis à travers le support de fixation d'échappement. Placer l'écrou M8 sur l'extrémité du boulon.
- Serrer tous les boulons de façon égale.
- Répéter les opérations énoncées ci dessus pour l'installation du côté opposé.



- Assurez-vous qu'aucune partie n'entre en contact lorsque la moto sera en route. Cela pourrait créer des dommages à la moto. (Ce point est particulièrement important si vous utilisez des pots d'échappement qui ne sont pas d'origine).

Il est de votre responsabilité de vous assurer qu'aucune partie de l'ensemble support de pot d'échappement n'entre en contact avec une autre partie de la moto. Ne pas prendre la route sans avoir fait ces vérifications. Compresser l'amortisseur arrière pour jauger de cet aspect par exemple (si le design de la moto le permet).

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
