

FITTING INSTRUCTIONS

- Carefully clean the radiator, being careful not to damage any of the fins.
- Remove the 2x bolts circled in **Picture 1** and repeat for the other side of the bike. Making sure to not let the side panels fall.
- Offer the radiator guard up to the radiator, lining up the slots in the side of the guard with the side panel mounts.
- Replace one side panel, clamping the radiator guard between the panel and the panel mounts using the OEM bolts. Please ensure that no part of the radiator guard is contacting the fins of the radiator.
- Repeat this process for the other side of the bike.

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CONSUMER NOTICE



NOTICE DE MONTAGE

- Nettoyez soigneusement le radiateur en veillant à ne pas endommager les ailettes.
- Retirez les deux boulons entourés sur la photo 1 et répétez l'opération de l'autre côté de la moto. Veillez à ne pas laisser tomber les panneaux latéraux.
- Présentez la protection du radiateur du radiateur en alignant les fentes latérales de la protection avec les supports de panneau latéral.
- Remettez le panneau latéral en place en serrant la protection du radiateur entre le panneau et les supports de panneau à l'aide des boulons d'origine. Assurez-vous qu'aucune partie de la protection du radiateur n'entre en contact avec les ailettes du radiateur.
- Répétez cette opération de l'autre côté de la moto.

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
