

LEGEND

ITEM 1 = SPINDLE BAR (SB090 APPROX 237.5mm LONG) (x1)

ITEM 2 = M8 WASHER (19mm OUTSIDE DIAMETER) (x1).

ITEM 3 = M8 NYLOC NUT (x1).

ITEM 4 = R-H-S CRASH PROTECTOR (B0442 M8 (8mm INTERNAL DIAMETER)) (x1).

ITEM 5 = RIGHT-HAND SPACER (S0512, 70mm OUTSIDE DIAMETER) (x1).

ITEM 6 = LEFT-HAND THREADED SPACER (S0733) (x1).

ITEM 7 = L-H-S CRASH PROTECTOR (B0442 M6 (6mm INTERNAL DIAMETER)) (x1).

Please note that in cases where kits are packed with rubber washers holding the components onto the bolt – *the rubber washers should be thrown away*!

TOOLS REQUIRED

- SOCKET SET TO INCLUDE 13 AND 21mm SOCKETS
- SMALL AMOUNT OF SEMI-PERMANENT THREAD LOCK.

FITTING INSTRUCTIONS

- PLACE THE SPINDLE BAR (ITEM 1) INTO THE THREADED SPACER (ITEM 6);
 PLEASE ENSURE THE THREADS ARE FULLY ENGAGED. IT IS A GOOD IDEA TO
 USE A SMALL AMOUNT OF SEMI-PERMANENT THREAD LOCK TO SECURE IN
 PLACE
- PLACE THE ASSEMBLY THROUGH THE REAR SPINDLE FROM THE LEFT HAND SIDE SO THE SPACER LOCATES INTO THE REAR WHEEL SPINDLE AS SHOWN IN THE TOP LEFT PICTURE.
- PLACE THE LARGER SPACER (ITEM 5) OVER THE EXPOSED END OF THE SPINDLE BAR (AS SHOWN IN TOP RIGHT PICTURE).
- PLACE THE CRASH PROTECTOR (ITEM 4) OVER THE EXPOSED END OF THE SPINDLE BAR (AS SHOWN IN TOP RIGHT PICTURE).
- USE THE NUT AND WASHER (ITEMS 2 AND 3) AND SECURE IN PLACE. DO NOT OVER-TIGHTEN—THE NYLOC NUT WILL HOLD IT TIGHT.



ARTICLE 5 = Entretoise coté droit (S0512, 70mm Diamètre extérieur) (x1).

ARTICLE 6 = Entretoise filetée coté gauche (S0733) (x1).

ARTICLE 7 = Protection crash coté gauche (B0442 M6 (6mm Diamètre interne)) (x1).

OUTILS REQUIS

- Jeu de clés 13 et 21mm
- Un peu de frein filet semi permanent

Instructions de montage :

- Placer l'axe (Article 1) dans l'entretoise filetée (Article 6); en veillant à ce que les filetages soient complètement engagés. Il est bon d'utiliser un peu de frein filet semi permanent pour fixer la position.
- Placer l'ensemble à travers l'axe arrière depuis le coté gauche de façon à ce que l'entretoise se place dans l'axe de roue arrière (Photo en haut à gauche).
- Placer l'entretoise la plus large (Article 5) autour de l'extrémité de l'axe (Photo en haut à droite).
- Placer la protection crash (Article 4) autour de l'extrémité de l'axe (photo en haut à droite).
- Utiliser l'écrou et la rondelle (articles 2 et 3) et fixer la position. NE PAS BLOQUER L'écrou fixe la position.
