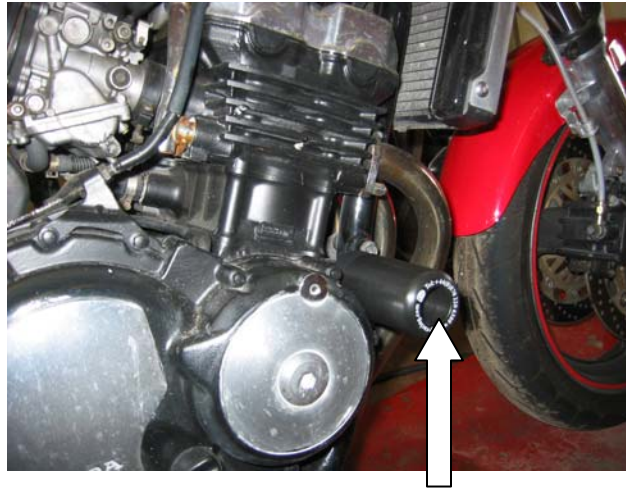




**FITTING INSTRUCTIONS FOR CP0218BL CRASH PROTECTORS  
HONDA CB400SF (ALSO CALLED THE BIG ONE OR SUPER FOUR) 1990-2000**

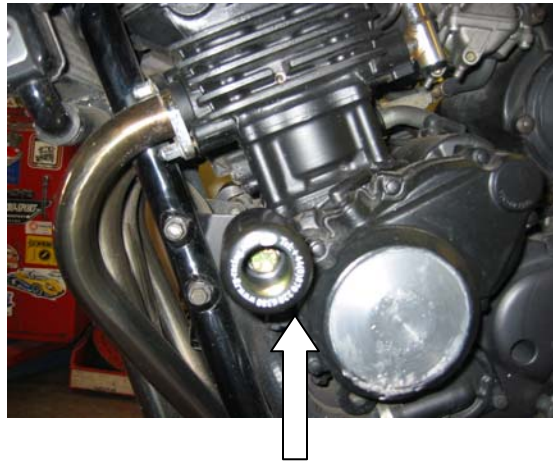


**Please note that the way the kit is packed does not necessarily represent the way of mounting to the bike**

Please note that in cases where kits are packed with rubber washers holding the components onto the bolt – *the rubber washers should be thrown away!*

**Right-hand side (as you sit on bike)**

- Remove the engine bolt arrowed above.
- Place the longest bolt complete with washer through bobbin and place larger black spacer over exposed end of bolt.
- Offer this assembly into position shown above and tighten bolt until you feel some compression from inside the protector. Turn a little more so that you feel the compression increase slightly. Then apply a quarter turn. Do not overtighten as damage can occur to the bike. Do not exceed 40nm of torque.



#### **Left-hand side (as you sit on bike)**

- Remove the engine bolt arrowed above.
- Place the shortest bolt complete with washer through bobbin and place the thin disc spacer over exposed end of bolt.
- Offer this assembly into position shown above and tighten bolt until you feel some compression from inside the protector. Turn a little more so that you feel the compression increase slightly. Then apply a quarter turn. Do not overtighten as damage can occur to the bike. Do not exceed 40nm of torque.

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
